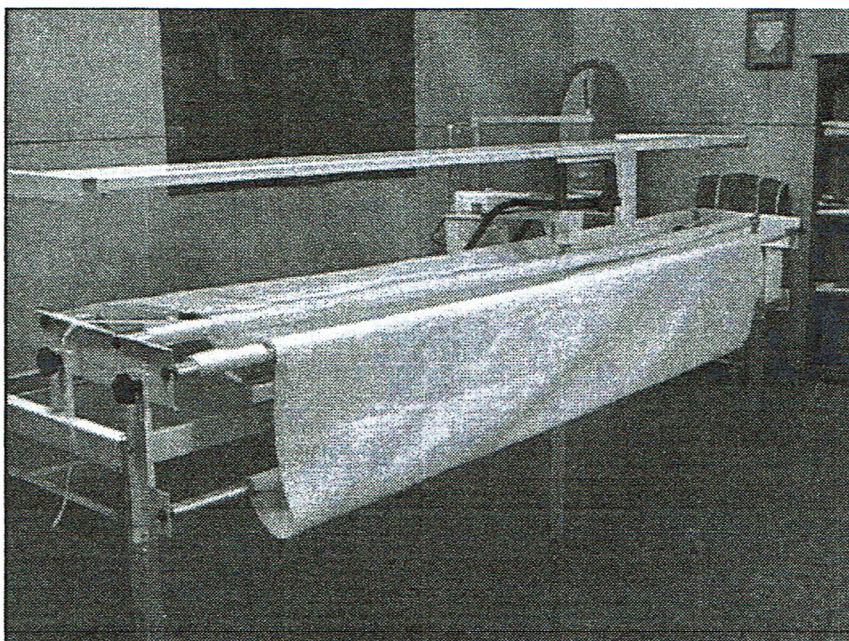

The following instructions are for the assembly of a full size Inspira Quilting Frame. To assemble the half size Inspira Quilting Frame follow the instructions included at Steps 1, 3, 20, and 30.

1. Place two legs parallel with one another on a flat surface with the open sides facing each other. Place a leg brace between the legs aligning the holes in the legs and the leg brace. This will form the letter "H". Attach the leg brace to the legs using 5/8" long flanged bolts and nuts. For best appearance, place all bolt heads on the exterior and

nuts on the interior. Tighten the bolts and nuts with the wrenches. Repeat 2 times to create 3 sets of "H" leg assemblies. (Note: only two sets of "H" leg assemblies are needed for the half-size Inspira Quilting Frame.)

2. Stand two "H" leg assemblies facing each other so the leg braces are closer to the top and the open sides of the leg braces are toward each other. Place a frame end on the top of each leg assembly, ensuring the frame end lower groove fits over the raised segment on top of the leg assembly. The holes in the frame end should align with the end holes of the legs. Place a 5/8" long cap screw through the frame end and allow it to drop completely to the bottom of the groove. Put nuts on the bottom side and finger tighten only. You will not need to use a wrench on the screw as you tighten the nuts. Repeat on all 4 corners.
