

## PHD\* QUILT CHALLENGE

*\*PHD: Project Half Done or Project Hunkering Doing*

To participate, list on an entry sheet 2 – 4 projects you would like to complete in this guild year. The date that your projects are due by are as follows: *(you may pick any date from the following that you like, just one date per project. They can't all be due on the same day.)*

PHD #1 – Tuesday, November 14, 2023 @ 7:00 pm

PHD #2 – Tuesday, February 13, 2024 @ 7:00 pm

PHD #3 – Tuesday, April 9, 2024 @ 7:00 pm

PHD #4 – Tuesday, June 11, 2024 @ 7:00 pm

Each project is assigned a \$5.00 value and due on entry to challenge. On the set due date, you will bring and show your completed PHD, you will be given a certificate of completion, your \$5 and your name will go into for the draw.

If you don't finish your PHD your \$5 goes into the 'kitty', give your poor excuse, you do your walk of shame and there's no draw entry. At the June meeting the draw for the 'kitty' funds will be done. Remember entries are only given out if you've completed a PHD project. (If there are no funds in the 'kitty' a prize will be given from the Guild.)

Rules for PHDs are: any project involving fabric, cut into for the purpose of making a project, being but not limited to; a quilt, wall hanging, bag, garment or object of art, totally or partially quilted and not complete. If you are away for a meeting when your PHD is due it is up to you to show your finished PHD either a guild meeting before, via email/text photos of it completed front and back or have a friend bring your project on your behalf. If none of these has been done, your PHD will be deemed unfinished.

Complete means: quilted, bound, labelled (only if you use labels) and ready for use.
